The Department of Public Works has agreed to a plan to relocate the crosswalk from Regester Avenue at Kenleigh Road, to Regester Avenue and Copeleigh Road. The crosswalk will be placed in front of 707 Regester Avenue, which is more central for the largest share of walkers to Stoneleigh Elementary School.

The design will be similar to the one recently approved at Overbrook Road and Regester Avenue. It will include bump-outs, a brick and concrete inlay, and new crossing signs. The crossing guard will be relocated here during school hours. The plan is to construct the new crosswalk at the same time as the Overbrook crosswalk this summer.

There will now be two traffic calming projects that should slow traffic along Regester Avenue, one in Anneslie and the one previously announced at Overbrook in Idlewyde.
